

# Public Information Meeting

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation has scheduled a public information meeting to present information and gather public comments on the corridor study now being done on US 14 between WIS 92 and I-39/90 in Dane and Rock Counties. The meeting will be held:

The meeting will be held in an open-house format with a brief presentation at 5:30 p.m. The open-house format provides citizens an opportunity to express their concerns regarding the current and emerging conditions along the route, and to view exhibits and meet individually with personnel from Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) and Oneida Total Integrated Enterprises (WisDOT consultant).

The purpose of this corridor study is to evaluate the existing roadway, understand future transportation needs for the US 14 corridor and evaluate possible roadway improvements that would improve safety and mobility along the corridor. Public involvement will play an important role in this study, which concludes with preparation of a Corridor Management Plan. This report will formally document the results of the study and will suggest a strategy for preserving US 14 as a two-lane highway for as long as possible. No construction projects are planned at this time.

The study is currently in the data gathering phase. Traffic counts and crash data have been collected and projections of future traffic levels have been completed. In addition, information has been collected about archaeological sites; historic buildings; wetlands and other natural resources; endangered species; and contaminated sites.
