To: Residents Affected by the 2013 Court Street Storm Sewer Improvements

Subject: Project Details

Dear Residents:

As you may already be aware, the City will be improving the storm sewer system along Court Street this fall. A project map is provided on the back of this sheet for reference.

The project will likely start during the week of September 9, and continue for 2-3 weeks.

As construction gets underway, there are several items that are important to know during the project. The scope of work is to construct a new storm sewer line from Main Street to the ditch along the north edge of West Side Park. The new storm sewer will increase capacity of the system and reduce the “blowouts” that sometimes occur during heavy rains. Once the storm sewer is completed, a new sidewalk will also be constructed from Hillside Court to West Side Park.

R&K and Sons, Inc. will be the general contractor for the storm sewer project. The storm sewer will be placed mainly off-street, but will cross Hillside Court just east of Court Street.

The contractor will maintain access to all homes as much as possible during construction. **However, traffic will be shut off on Hillside Court for approximately 4 hours during the road crossing.** Affected residents will be notified prior to any closure in order to move their vehicles, if needed. All driveways will have access restored at the end of each work day.
