***Are you registered to vote?
Do you need an absentee ballot?***

The City of Evansville Clerk's Office, 31 S Madison Street, Evansville, will provide extended hours on Tuesday, October 28th and Thursday, October 30th for residents within the city to register to vote and to vote absentee. Office hours will be from 7:30 a.m. – 7:00 p.m.

If you are unsure if you are properly registered, please visit the Voter Public Access website at <http://vpa.wi.gov> or contact the City Clerk's Office.

From October 16th through November 3rd, voters may register to vote at the City Clerk's Office only – proof of residence is required.

On November 4th, (Election Day), voters may register to vote at the polling place only – proof of residence is required.

New voters must provide their Wisconsin driver's license number or Wisconsin ID number, and write their name exactly as it appears on the license. If you have neither one, you may use the last four digits of your Social Security number.

You must be a registered voter to vote absentee.
