6 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE SMART GROWTH COMPREHENSIVE
7 PLAN IN RESPONSE TO DEVELOPMENT APPLICATION # 2006-27

9 The Common Council of the City of Evansville, Rock County, Wisconsin, do ordain as
10 follows:
11

12 SECTION 1. The City of Evansville, Wisconsin, has adopted a comprehensive plan as
13 defined in Sections 66.1001(1)(a) and 66.1001(2), Wis. Stats.
14

15 SECTION 2. Mayor Sandra J. Decker has submitted an application to amend the future
16 transportation map.
17

18 SECTION 3. The Plan Commission has reviewed the application and has by majority
19 vote of the entire commission adopted Plan Commission resolution # 2006-9 recommending the
20 proposed change to the Common Council.
21

22 SECTION 4. The Evansville Common Council has held a public hearing on October 10,
23 2006, in compliance with the requirements of Section 66.1001(d)(4), Wis. Stats., regarding the
24 recommended amendment.
25

26 SECTION 5. This amendment is consistent with the remaining sections of the
27 city's adopted comprehensive plan.
28

29 SECTION 6. The Common Council hereby amends the comprehensive plan by
30 changing the future transportation map as follows

- 31 (1) J. Lindemann: major collector
- 32 (2) Brown School road: minor collector
- 33 (3) Water Street: truck route
- 34 (4) Exchange Street: truck route
- 35 (5) Porter road: minor collector from 5th Street to city limits
- 36 (6) Main Street: minor collector from 4th Street to city limits
- 37 (7) Cemetery Road: future minor collector from USH 14 to city limits

39 SECTION 7. The city clerk/treasurer shall send a copy of this ordinance to the following
