


CITY OF EVANSVILLE
ORDINANCE #2008-13

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE SMART GROWTH COMPREHENSIVE
PLAN IN RESPONSE TO DEVELOPMENT APPLICATION #2008-22

The Common Council of the City of Evansville, Rock County, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. The City of Evansville, Wisconsin, has adopted a comprehensive plan as defined in Sections 66.1001(1)(a) and 66.1001(2), Wis. Stats.

SECTION 2. Dysis Group LLC has submitted an application on behalf of the Daria Every Trust, which owns parcel 6-20-168 and 6-20-231 in the Town of Union, to change the land use designation of that portion of parcel 6-20-168 labeled "A" in the location map below on the interim future land use map and the future land use map to walkable neighborhood and that portion of parcel 6-20-231 labeled "B" in the location map below as walkable neighborhood on the interim future land use map.



SECTION 3. The Plan Commission has reviewed the application and, by majority vote of the entire commission, has adopted Plan Commission Resolution #2008-2 recommending the proposed change to the Common Council.

SECTION 4. The Evansville Common Council has held a public hearing on August 12, 2008, in compliance with the requirements of Section 66.1001(d)(4), Wis. Stats., regarding the proposed amendment of the comprehensive plan.


SECTION 5. This amendment is consistent with the remaining sections of the city's adopted comprehensive plan.

SECTION 6. The Common Council hereby amends the comprehensive plan as described in Section 2.
