

CITY OF EVANSVILLE
ORDINANCE #2011-04

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE
CITY OF EVANSVILLE COMPREHENSIVE PLAN

The Common Council of the City of Evansville, Rock County, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. The City of Evansville, Wisconsin, adopted the *City of Evansville Comprehensive Plan* in June, 2005, in compliance with Wisc. Stats. s 66.1001(1)(a) and 66.1001(2).

SECTION 2. City of Evansville staff, working under the direction of the Plan Commission, have prepared a proposed *Comprehensive Plan Amendment* dated February 8, 2011.

SECTION 3. The Plan Commission conducted a public hearing on May 2, 2011, in compliance with Wisc. Stats. s.66.1001(4)(d), regarding the proposed *Comprehensive Plan Amendment*.

SECTION 4. The Plan Commission has adopted a Resolution recommending that the Common Council approve an Ordinance adopting the proposed *Comprehensive Plan Amendment*.

SECTION 5. The Evansville Common Council held a second public hearing on June 14, 2011 regarding the proposed *Comprehensive Plan Amendment*.

SECTION 6. The proposed amendment is consistent with the remaining sections of the adopted *City of Evansville Comprehensive Plan*.

SECTION 7. The proposed amendment, together with the adopted *City of Evansville Comprehensive Plan*, contain all of the elements set forth in Wisc. Stats. 66.1001(2)

SECTION 8. The Common Council hereby amends the *City of Evansville Comprehensive Plan* as described in the proposed *Comprehensive Plan Amendment* dated May 3, 2011.
