Local Contractors/Suppliers

The City of Evansville encourages local contractors and suppliers to be active in the construction bidding process for the City's upgrade of the existing wastewater treatment facility. The request for construction bids was public noticed on April 29, 2009. Construction bids are due May 28, 2009 at 3:00 p.m., local time.

The wastewater treatment project is being bid as one lump sum contract which will include all the specific disciplines identified in the project documents. These disciplines include site excavation/grading, concrete, instrumentation, electrical, HVAC, mechanical, plumbing, building construction, process treatment equipment, landscaping and plantings.

The City's engineer, Foth Infrastructure & Environment, LLC, is completing the bidding process for the City. They will be maintaining a bidder's list which shows each bidder who has requested plans/specifications for the project. The cost of the plans are \$150 for a 11" X 17" size plan set and \$250 for a 24" X 36" plan set. Foth will also be sending out and distributing plan sets as requested. Please call Foth Infrastructure & Environment, LLC at 608-242-5900 to purchase a plan set and to get on the bidder's list.

Contractors and suppliers may also review the plan sets at the Evansville City Hall, Evansville Public Works, and the office of Foth Infrastructure & Environment, LLC. These plan sets are available for review only and will not be allowed to be taken from the site. All bidders must review the plan sets in detail prior to providing bids to the general contractors. A pre-bid meeting will be held at the Wastewater Treatment Facility on May 12, 2009 at 11:00 a.m., local time.
