

The construction is comprised of two separate contracts.

The first is for underground utility work. The City of Evansville has hired G. Fox & Son of Janesville under this contract. Work will begin March 31 and continue through June 7.

- Sanitary sewer improvements
 - Six-inch sanitary sewer forcemain from Leota Park to Garfield Street
 - Reconstruction of lift station at Leota Park
 - Replacement of eleven manholes between Walker and Church Streets
 - Replacement of sanitary sewer main at Water Street
- Water improvement
 - Ten-inch watermain and services between Walker and Church Streets

The second is for the street surface. The Wisconsin Department of Transportation has hired Payne & Dolan of Madison under this contract. Work is scheduled to begin June 9 and continue through the summer.

- Street improvements
 - Replace 20 inches of base and new asphalt surface from Church Street north to Allen Creek bridge
 - Mill and overlay surface from Church Street south past Walker Street
 - New concrete surface at Four Corners (Main and Madison Streets)
 - Widen intersection at Water and Madison Streets
 - Re-align intersection at Old Highway 92 and Madison Street
 - Install sidewalk on east side of Madison Street south of Walker Street
 - Limited replacement of curb and gutter throughout project
