Instructions to voters

If you make a mistake

on your ballot or have a question, see an election inspector. (Absentee voters: Contact your municipal clerk.)

1.) Select your party preference

You may vote in only ONE party section at a partisan primary.

- If you **designate** a party preference, votes cast in that party section will be counted. Votes cast in any other party section will not be counted.
- If you **do not designate** a party preference, and you vote in more than one party, no votes will be counted.

2.) Vote for individual candidates

Vote for ONE candidate for each contest in your selected party.

- To vote for a name on the ballot, complete the arrow next to the name like this:
