

## Swimming Lessons

All swim lessons are taught by both Red Cross Certified Water Safety Instructors and in house trained swimming instructors. All of our instructors follow National Red Cross Standards.



## Veterans Memorial Aquatic Center RULES & POLICIES

### A Safe & Friendly Swimming Environment

Here at Veterans Memorial Aquatic Center, we want everyone to have fun and feel safe! If someone prevents this from happening, or you feel threatened or harassed, please contact a staff member immediately. ~~We can't help unless we are made aware of what is going on.~~

### Strict Adherence to the Rules & Regulations

The following rules are established for the best interest in safety and sanitation. Penalty for violations of the rules may result in suspension of swimming privileges. Please refer to our discipline policy for specific procedures regarding suspension of swimming privileges.

### General Rules

- Towel snapping, pushing and unnecessary roughness prohibited.
- Food, drink, gum, or tobacco products are not allowed in the aquatic center.
- Patrons are not allowed in the aquatic-center that have a communicable disease or an open cut.
- No running, drinking, or jumping close to other swimmers.
- Do not disturb lifeguards while on duty.
- No swimming while solar blanket is in place.
- Glass and shatter able items are prohibited in the aquatic center.
- State law requires showering after using toilet facilities and before entering the pool.
- Lap swim area is for adults only when the lane is in place & during designated swim times.
- No animals permitted in the aquatic center.
- Anyone under the influence of drugs or alcohol is prohibited from use of aquatic center
- Only permitted in the diving board area during designated diving times. No diving from the sides of the rest of the pool. Except during designated side dive time.
- Patrons can get their baskets twice during the day and once at night.
- Harassing or bullying of other patrons will not be tolerated.

### Diving Area Rules

- Only one person allowed on the board at one time.
- Non-swimmers are not permitted to use the board. No catching children going off the board.
- One bounce only and swim to the nearest ladder.
- Go off the end of the board only and not the sides.
- You must wait until the person is off before climbing the ladder.
- Be sure the area is clear before leaving the board.
- The use of swimming accessories such as arm floats, life jackets, masks, goggles, fins, etc. are not allowed when using the board.

### Kiddy Slide Rules

- For non-swimmer with designated bracelets.
- Non-swimmers must be accompanied by an adult in the water at all times.
- No kneeling, rotating, or stopping in the flume. Leave plunge area immediately.
- No one standing on the ladder. Area must be clear before leaving.
- Go down the slide feet first.
- The use of swimming accessories such as tubes, masks, goggles, fins etc. are not allowed when using the slide.

### Deep Water Slide Rules

- Only one on the slide at a time.
- No one standing on the ladder. Area must be clear before leaving. No kneeling, rotating, or stopping in the flume.
- The use of swimming accessories such as arm floats, life jackets, masks, fins, tubes, floats etc. are not allowed.
- Non-swimmers not allowed use of the slide. No catching children going off the slide.

## POOL POLICIES

### Age Requirements

All non-swimmers (ages 3-5) must wear a non-swimmers bracelet (yellow) & are not allowed to take the aquatic center's water test. Non-swimmers are required to be under adult supervision with an adult in the water at all times and within arms reach of their children. Children must stay in the water that is armpit depth or less. Children ages 6-7 have the option of taking a swim test. Those who pass the swim test will receive a swimmers bracelet (blue) each time they come to the aquatic center indicating they have passed the swim test.

**The "0" Depth Swim Area** is for swimmers of all ages and abilities.

*\*Non-Swimmers must be under adult supervision of an adult in the water at all times.*

### Parent & Adult Supervision of Non-Swimmers

Parents must be in swimming attire and in the water with their children, no more than an arm's length away. When children are using kiddy slide, parents are to be at the foot of the slide. Arm floats & life jackets are not a substitute for in-water supervision. There is to be no catching of children off slides or diving board. All rules & regulations must be obeyed. Please engage in safe play.

### Water Test

The water test consists of the following:  
Swimming (1 & 1/2) lengths of the pool without stopping using one of the four basic Swimming strokes and treading water for no less than (2) minutes in deep water.

### Water Testing Times (During Rest Period)

M-F: 12:30-1:00pm, 8:15-8:45pm  
Sat/Sun: 1:00-1:30pm

### Pool Area Street Clothes Policy

Parents wishing to be on deck in street clothes to accompany their swimmer) ages 8 and over or children 6 & 7 who have passed the swim

test must pay the regular admission price. We request that parents in street clothes remain by the fence line away from the pool water. During swimming lessons, we require that all parents remain outside the fence.

### Swim Diaper Requirement

Infants and non-toilet trained children are required to wear **swim diapers** when using the pool. Please be sure to use diapers designed specifically for swimming. For your convenience, diapers are available for sale in the basket room. \*Diaper changing not all owed on deck & only allowed in dressing room area.

### Lost & Found

Veterans Memorial Aquatic Center is not responsible for lost or stolen articles. The aquatic center does have a lost & found at the front desk. Items are only kept for a period of two weeks.

### Inclement Weather

**Cold Weather:** When the air temperature is "69" degrees or lower the aquatic center will not open. During cool or poor weather conditions, the aquatic center hours will be adjusted without notice. If there are less than (10) patrons in the pool during a scheduled swim session, management reserves the right to close early without notice. Patrons should call ahead before coming to the aquatic center on poor weather days.

**Rain\Non-Severe Weather:** During these conditions, the aquatic center will temporarily close and swimmers will be asked to report to the dressing rooms. In cases of prolonged rain at the scheduled opening, the center will not open. If weather clears by 2:30pm the center will re-open at that time.

**Storms\Severe Weather Warnings:** The pool will close and swimmers will be sent home. For the afternoon session if the weather clears by 2:30, the pool will open again at 2:30pm. If the pool closes because of severe weather in the evening, the pool will not re-open again that evening.

**Swimming Lessons:** We do not schedule make up dates for lessons cancelled due to poor weather.

### Aquatic Center Membership Policy

Membership may only be used by those that the membership is registered. Patrons forgetting a membership will be charged \$2 to swim. After a 2<sup>nd</sup> time the membership card must be replaced at a fee of \$5. Memberships are not honored during special events or activities. Photo ID cards will be made for each membership sold.

**Misuse of the membership rules will result in a non-refundable revocation of the membership. Memberships are Non-refundable.**

### Aquatic Center Phone

The aquatic center phone is generally not for public use. However, in cases of emergency, the aquatic staff will allow children to use the phone to call home. We do not take calls on the phone to relay messages to patrons.
