Dear Property/Business Owner:

My name is Pat Gardner and I will be the project manager for the reconstruction of the East Main Street Allen Creek Bridge, in the City of Evansville. The intent of this letter is to inform you of the upcoming project and to schedule an informational meeting with all businesses affected by the reconstruction project. **The informational meeting for affected businesses will be held on June 28, 2011 at 6:00 p.m.** The meeting location will be at the public works building at 535 S. Madison Street.

Main Street will be closed approximately 100 feet on either side of the bridge. The USH 14 intersection will not be affected by this closure. There will be no signed detour for this project.

The City of Evansville along with the Chamber of Commerce are working together to come up with a way to sign the city as to notify the public that the downtown area is still open and accessible.

The closure will tentatively begin on the week of July 25th and will end around the end of September. Access to your businesses will be maintained throughout the construction project.

If you have any existing private storm or roof drains, please contact me so that I can make the necessary changes to accommodate the flow. If you have any irrigation systems near the right of way, please contact me so we can avoid damaging your system during construction.

You can contact me by phone at 608-365-4464. I will normally be on the job between 7 AM and 5 PM; however, I will be available to stay after hours if prior arrangements are made.
