ORDINANCE 2016-17**

**Amending Chapter 122 -191 of the Municipal Code,
Abandonment Prohibited**

Section 122-191, of the City Code shall be created as follows:

Sec. 122-191. Forty-eight (48) hour parking prohibited.


Forty-eight (48) Hour Limitation. No person, firm or corporation shall park, leave standing and/or unattended any automobile, truck, motorcycle, or vehicle (including but not limited to any vehicle as the defined by section 340.01 (74) of the Wisconsin statutes) of any description on any public street, public parking lot or other City-owned property in the City for a period of Forty-eight (48) or more consecutive hours in the same location at any time, except that where more restrictive parking limits have been established the more restrictive limits shall apply. When any law enforcement officer shall find a vehicle standing upon a public street, parking lot or other City-owned property in violation of the provisions of this Section, he is authorized to move such a vehicle or to require the operator in charge thereof to move such vehicle to a position permitted under this Chapter. The law enforcement officer may cause said vehicle to be removed to a proper impoundment and storage area and in such case the owner shall pay the costs of removing said vehicle and the storage fees on said vehicle before he may recover the possession thereof.
