Temporary Outdoor Sales for Evansville Businesses

Business Owners,

Recent Economic and Health news relating to COVID-19 have created uncertainty for the next few weeks. Last night, the Economic Development Committee discussed resources for local businesses that find themselves limiting in-person interactions. The Committee identified a need to encourage and allow outdoor sales.

Therefore, to help Evansville Businesses, the Community Development Director is **allowing Temporary Outdoor Sales per Section 130-561 of the [Evansville Municipal Code](#) to operate drive-up and curbside sales and pick-up in all commercially zoned districts for the next 60 days, until Monday, May 18th, 2020.** This authorization will only require a business to notify the director of their participation by emailing Jason at: jason.sergeant@ci.evansville.wi.gov.

Additionally, the City is working with the [Evansville Area Chamber of Commerce and Tourism](#) to coordinate promotion of businesses that have online sales or gift card purchases. If your business offers this, please send your information to the Executive Director of The Chamber via [this form](#) or by email at: evansvillechamber@gmail.com as soon as possible.
