



VOTE BY MAIL, PLEASE

- Log in to <https://myvote.wi.gov>
- Request an absentee ballot for the November 3, 2020 General Election
- After receiving your absentee ballot and return envelope
 1. Vote your ballot in the presence of a witness
 2. Seal the ballot in the return envelope
 3. Sign your certification/return envelope
 4. Have your witness sign your certification/return envelope AND write their full address where indicated
- Drop your signed and witnessed return envelope in the mail or drop it off at city hall. There is a payment drop box outside the ramp entrance to city hall you can use. It is primarily for utility payments but ballots fit fine.
