- 8. **Police Department Report.** McElroy reported on Siren testing, storm damages from the July 7<sup>th</sup> morning storm, testing a different body camera, radar trailer use, and issues with the squad cameras. McElroy reported in the month of June there were 39 license plate transactions 978 calls for service compared to 792 calls for service in June of 2015.
  - A. McElroy and Rigg presented an ordinance change regarding trailers on public right-of-ways. The Committee decided to review the ordinance, ask for clarifications and make alterations before recommending it to Common Council next meeting.
